## Section 1. Authority.

This Local Law is enacted pursuant to the authority of Article 9A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, and shall be known as the Games of Chance Law of the Town of Edmeston, New York.

## Section 2. Definition.

The words and terms used in this Local Law shall have the same meaning as such words and terms are used in Article 9A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York.

## Section 3. Games of Chance Authorized Restrictions.

Games of Chance may be conducted in the Town of Edmeston, New York by an authorized organization, after obtaining a license therefore, in accordance with the provisions, requirements and limitations of Article 9A of the General Municipal Law, the rules and regulations of the New York State Racing and Wagering Board and this Local Law.

## Section 4. Enforcement.

The Powers and Duties of set forth in Subdivision 1 of Section 194 of the General Municipal Law shall be exercised by the Chief Law Enforcement Officer of the County of Otsego.

## Section 5. Effective Date.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of




